How do I find out about Coaching?

Volunteer coaches are an integral part of the YMCA Youth Sports program.

If you are interested in coaching, please visit with the sports director at the YMCA for more information.

Objective

To teach the fundamentals of football, team play, sportsmanship, and fitness. This program will furnish each player with football pads and equipment to compete against other teams from other towns in the same grade level.

When are Practices?

Practices are set by the coach of the team. You will have 2-3 practices a week up to the first game. After that, you are allowed 2 per week

When are Games?

Games are on Saturdays and usually start the 2nd Saturday in September. League schedules are made by the Mid State Football league and will come out in the middle of August. You will play 50% of games at home while the others will be away at other towns.

What does my player need?

Football pants...Wait to purchase till the coach of your team tells you the pant color.

Football Cleats... No metal spikes are allowed.

Practice Jersey...Any color will do or use old game jersey from past years.

Shoulder Pads and Helmet...These will be provided to you at equipment checkout. Must turn back in at the end of season.

Mouth Piece...Sold at Equipment checkout

Physical... Is needed. Attach to registration.

NEW Rookie Tackle Football 1st / 2nd Grade

The Rookie Program is a NEW program for the Mid State Football League. It is a bridge between flag football and 11 man tackle football.

Games are played on half size fields with 8 players.

Rule modifications result in more snaps on offense and defense for younger players.

Participants rotate and learn multiple positions and skills on offense and defense.

Provides a greater coach-to-player ratio to foster individual attention and skill development.

Safety is also key to this program.
